BEDROCK- WINDOWS 10

- Download the zip folder. This contains a .mcworld file
- Open Minecraft
- Click Play
- Click on the import map button. This is located next to the create new button, and highlighted green on the image below:



- Navigate your folders to locate the .mcworld file you have just downloaded onto your device. It may be saved in your downloads folder by default.
- Click on the mcworld file (or select the file and click Open), and this will import the .mcworld file into Minecraft.
- You should now see the Archiverse world as an option in your world list.



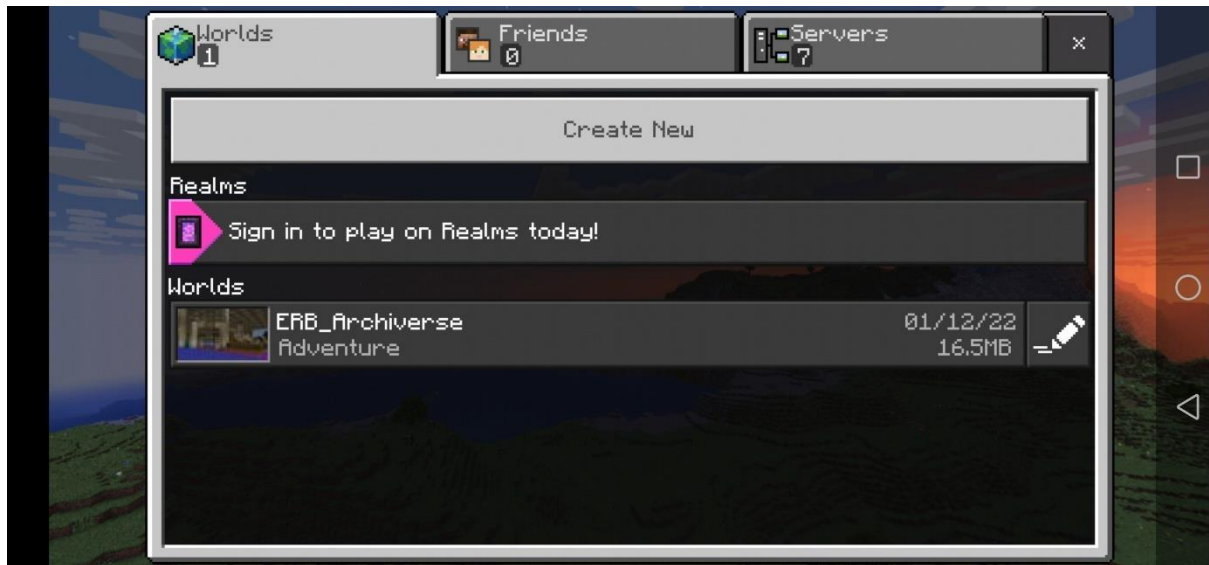
- Click on the world to join.

BEDROCK- POCKET EDITION

- Download the zip folder. This contains a .mcworld file
- Navigate your folders to locate the .mcworld file you have just downloaded onto your device. It may be saved in your downloads folder by default.
- Select the .mcworld file, and you should be given the option to open the file in your Minecraft app.
- Select the option to open the file in your Minecraft app and it will open your Minecraft PE app automatically and will import your world.
- You will now see the Archiverse world appear on your worlds list



- Click on the world to join.
- You will now find yourself in front of the Treasure House (turn around if it's not directly in front of you!)

JAVA EDITION

- Download the zip folder.
- Navigate to your folder download, and unzip the files (right click, and click extract). You should now have an unzipped folder called 'ERB-Archiverse'.
- Copy and paste the entire ERB-Archiverse folder into your Minecraft Java world saves folder. On Windows, the default directory will begin with %APPDATA%\minecraft
For example: `Users\[username]\AppData\Roaming\minecraft\saves`
- Open Minecraft Java edition.
- Click 'Singleplayer'.
- You will find the Archiverse map now available in your worlds list. Click on this world.
- Click "Play selected world" to join.
- You will now find yourself in front of the Treasure House (turn around if it's not directly in front of you!)
